THE DOMINO EFFECT THE SUPREME COURT GAY MARRIAGE DECISION A NATION IN CRISIS



Thirty-five Years Ago. The following article was reported in the January 1988 issue of The Doorkeeper Report [also known as the Reflector].

COURT REJECTS SCHOOL PRAYER AGAIN

The U. S., Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit has ruled that Christian prayer in school commencement activities violates the principle of separation of church and state required by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution. The decision, handed down July 6, 1987, involved the use of prayer in a graduation ceremony in public schools in Plainwell and Portage, Michigan. The Court held that such prayer "symbolically places the government's seal of approval on one religious view—the Christian view." The Court added that the use of "civil invocations or benedictions would be acceptable. The case is known as Stein vs Plainwell Community Schools.
